The key lies in Matthew 11:12 when it declares that the kingdom of heavens suffers violence and the violent take it by force! This is a kingdom mindset. In order to continue in your true heavenly calling you must be forceful and intense about where you are going and have the perseverance to maintain it. I believe this very moment someone is reading this right now and the enemy has caused you chaos in your life to destroy you but I DECLARE what the enemy has meant to destroy will make you indestr-uctible! In Jesus Name!
